- ✓ **Stay Home if Unwell:** If your child has any symptoms consistent with the flu (influenza), COVID, or any other highly contagious diseases, please keep your child home. If anyone living in the household is ill with the flu (influenza), COVID, or any other highly contagious diseases please keep your child at home. If your child presents symptoms consistent with the flu (influenza), COVID, or any other highly contagious diseases the Museum reserves the right to send them home immediately. If you kindly let us know in advance that your child is sick and keep them at home, we will work with you to credit your payment toward future camps or membership. If you send your child to camp unwell, we will send them home, and we do not guarantee a payment credit. **Symptoms include fever (Temperature greater than 100.4F), cough, chills, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle or body aches, headache, fatigue (tiredness), vomiting, and diarrhea.**

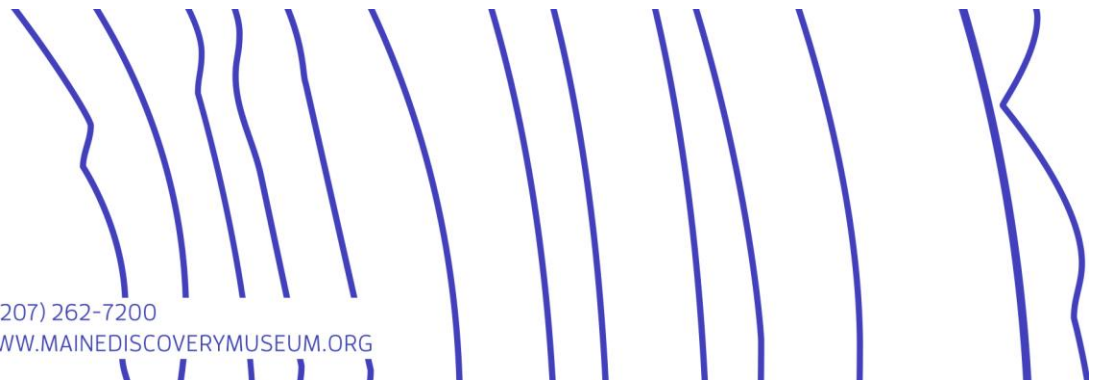

Such behaviors may include verbal or physical aggression, vandalism, running away, hiding, and other actions that create complete disruptions of the camp day. In serious cases we reserve the right to remove a child from camp for the day, sending him/her home, or barring him/her from camp altogether. No refunds will be issued in this case.
