July 26th - 30th

You Build it - Ages 5 - 10

Are you a tinkerer, inventor, and builder? Get ready to be an engineer and set up your lab, workshop and get started on your research like a scientist! Design, build and test your crazy, fun inventions to solve some real world problems. Investigate useful tools with real switches and batteries. Help animals crossing a busy highway by designing and testing a model nature bridge. Make a public park safe with your own rainwater runoff system. Solve challenging, fun engineering problems with your ingenuity, recyclables, real science tools and some AA batteries!

August 9th - 13th

Crazy for Cardboard! - Ages 5 - 10

Think outside the box! Bend, cut, color, twist, tape and shape and make your imagination and inventions come to life. Explore the science and history of this amazing material as you examine paper wasp nests and make your own plant fiber papers. Find out how your community recycles and reuses and what you can do to help. If you are a tinkerer, thinker and inventor create with this incredibly strong, shapeable, sustainable recyclable: A kid size space shuttle, room sized marble run, whole suit of armor, or even a whole box city, what will you create with cardboard?

August 9th - 13th

River Raiders @ Hirundo - Ages 8 - 12

Calling all budding naturalists and wildlife scientists! Discover and learn, get muddy, wet, and have fun! Join us for a fun-filled week of nature discoveries! Experience Maine's amazing flora and fauna by foot and by boat. Explore ancient archaeological sites. Foraging for safe edible plants, learning woodcraft, and basic canoeing skills are all part of this amazing week of a summer in Maine at camp. Campers should be prepared for a full day of physical activities and engaging lessons.

August 16th - 20th

Wonder Lab - Ages 5 - 10

Put on your safety goggles, lab coats, spark your curiosity and get ready for slimy explosions, spinning colors, blooming liquids and colorful crystals. Explore why matter matters when you paint, what light has to do with color, how gravity works when you sculpt, how motion is a must and where chemistry and creativity come together in camp Wonder Lab!

August 23rd - 27th

All Play All Day - Ages 5 - 10

Do you love playing and inventing games with puppets, props and toys, and act out your own stories? We will make everything we need to play our games: boards and pieces, props, toys, cards and even dice! We'll try out indoor and outdoor games from different cultures and times. It's all play all day for all campers this week!



We are thrilled to be able to offer camp this Summer. We can't wait to see your children and provide them with much needed S.T.E.A.M. discoveries.

This summer camp is being offered to our friends ages 5-10 with 1 week of off-site outdoor camp for ages 8-12.

Camp will run Monday-Friday with different themes each week. With the exception of our bonus week of offsite camp (Week of August 9th), camp will be held at the Museum.

Camp will run each day from 9 AM - 4 PM

- Drop off is between 8:30 AM - 9 AM
- Pick-up is between 3:30 PM - 4 PM

The cost per week is \$300.00 for members, \$350.00 for non-members.

We will reach out to families individually following registration to ensure everyone is prepared for an awesome camp experience.

Health & Safety

All museum staff will all be fully vaccinated prior to the start of camp.

Well-fitting face masks must be worn by all campers.

Camps will consist of two cohorts of 15 or less children with dedicated staff.

Cohorts will remain together throughout the day, every day.

Camp staff will ensure:

- At least 3 feet between all campers within a cohort.
- At least 6 feet between cohorts.
- At least 6 feet while eating and drinking, including among individuals within the same cohort.

Children must stay home if sick or having symptoms of COVID-19. If a camper develops a fever or shows any symptoms of COVID-19 they will be isolated and parents will be contacted to immediately pick-up their child.

Should an entire cohort of campers need to quarantine:

- MDM will provide home activity kits.
- Unfortunately, we are unable to provide refunds if a camp has to quarantine.

Families and campers are expected to do their part to keep everyone safe this summer.
